

Winston Hills Netball Club (WHNC) encourages all coaches to make their players available for borrowing into higher graded teams. As a community club, WHNC values teamwork and see the entire club as part of our team. It is the responsibility of every coach to know and understand the borrowing policy set down by Baulkham Hills Shire Netball Association (BHSNA).

All Coaches, who are borrowing players, must notify the WHNC Registrar prior to the game to ensure they meet the strict borrowing guidelines set down by BHSNA.

The WHNC Registrar, players and coaches are responsible for keeping a tally of borrowed players, as no player may be borrowed more than three times during the course of the season overall.

A maximum of two borrowed players can be used in any one game. There must be five original players from that team that take the court at all times.

A player must not be borrowed by more than one team on the same day.

Once a player has been borrowed twice, the Coach, Manager & Player/Parent will be notified via email and cannot be borrowed again for the rest of the season unless approved by WHNC Committee.

No junior player may play in a grade that is two years above their own grade.

A Net Set Go player can play across their age and be borrowed up into a team that is one age group higher only.

Any player borrowed three times per season will then become a member of one of the higher graded teams in which they were borrowed.

The borrowing policy with the junior and senior borrowing tables can be found on the BHSNA website www.bhsna.nsw.netball.com.au or on the WHNC webpage. These will be updated regularly, please always refer to BHSNA for latest versions.

All players borrowed must have prior written approval from the WHNC Registrar for any final series games.
